Expenditure (2)

- This year's UWCGB activity expenditure has increased by £ 650
- However, last year, a number of committee members were funded to got the World Congress – total cost £ 2,296
- So, in fact, UWCGB activity expenditure has increased by nearer £3K
- The cost of the orientation weekend has increased significantly and although costs are kept to a minimum we ill be increasing the cost of attended
- Some of the increase is due to the increased activity of our expanded welfare section is a critical part of our on going duty of care to our students
- General cost are not significant different
